



## International Student Guide: Renew your Temporary Resident Visa (TRV)

If your TRV has expired and you want to leave and re-enter the country, you must renew it. ***If your passport or study permit will expire*** soon, you must apply for a new passport and/or study permit **before** applying for your TRV.

*There are two steps to renew your TRV in Canada:*

- *submit an online application and wait for approval*
- *mail your passport to the visa office in Ottawa*

Follow these instructions:

**1. Create or Login to your IRCC account:**

**2. Complete the questionnaire**

Scroll down to “**Start an Application**”, and choose “**Apply to come to Canada**”. Scroll down to “**I do not have a Personal Reference Code**”, and click on:

**Visitor, study and/or work permit**

Input these answers to access the correct application. The first are mostly personal information, so input what is true for your situation.

Determine your Eligibility	Answers
What would you like to do in Canada?	<b>Study</b>
How long are you planning to stay in Canada?	Temporarily – more than 6 months
What is your current country of residence?	Canada
What is your current immigration status in Canada?	Student

**You will be directed to proceed with either “Study Permit” or “Temporary Resident Visa” – choose to continue with Temporary Resident Visa.**

### 3. Continue with the questionnaire

You should now see your **Document Checklist**. The form to complete is **IMM5257 - Application for Visitor Visa (Temporary Resident Visa) Made Outside of Canada (IMM 5257)**. This is the form you need to fill out, even when you apply from inside Canada.

You may see “Optional Documents” – these are not mandatory.

The fee for a Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) is \$100.

<b>Signature</b>	<p>You don't need to print and sign the form – instead, click <b>"Validate"</b> and then save this version (the last page should be a bar code). This is the version that you will upload online.</p>

#### 4. Scan and upload the supporting documents:

- digital photo (420x540 pixels)
- passport pages (only pages with stamps, visas, photos) saved as one single PDF document (less than 4MB)
- study permit
- confirmation of enrolment letter from NSCC Registrar's Office
- proof of financial support (statement of balance from your bank)
- others as indicated in your Document Checklist

#### 5. Pay the application fee (\$100.00) with a credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express).

Please make sure you see the official receipt on the screen.

#### 6. **Submit the application.**

Once your application has been successfully transmitted, you will see a confirmation of application submission under "My Messages".

#### 7. **Wait for a response from IRCC and mail your passport**

Once your application has been processed, IRCC will send you an email and direct you to your "MyCIC" account to check your messages (under "My Messages").

- Go to "My Messages", **print the IRCC letter** to be mailed with your passport
- **Purchase two prepaid Xpresspost envelopes**—national envelopes at any Canada Post retail outlet.
- **On the large envelope** – write your address as "Sender/From", and this address as "Recipient/Receiver/To"

- **On the small envelope** – write your address as "Recipient/Receiver/To"
- **Enclose one envelope in the other envelope along with your passport and IRCC letter.** IRCC will use the small envelope to return your passport and new TRV to you.
